




On-street Parking

Disc Zones offer free, time-limited parking on some streets in the town centre. **You must display a clock disc showing the correct time of arrival.** Check the disc zone signs for the maximum permitted parking time. These vary from 20 minutes to 2 hours.

Discs can be obtained from shops in the town centre, or from the Council centre to the rear of Fairfield car park.



If you park before you have a disc, display your time of arrival on a piece of paper on the dashboard where it can be seen from the outside.
